



Piano Keyboarding

2nd – 8th Class

Note reading, composing and musical fun are all part of Piano Keyboarding Class! Lessons are taught using Yamaha keyboards. Students progress at their own pace with individualized instruction. Group music games and activities add variety and fun to the class. Even if your child has never played an instrument, they will be playing “Jingle Bells” for relatives this Christmas!

A unique program designed by the instructor teaches note reading in a fun and easy to learn way. Instruction is interactive and uses a variety of materials to teach the concepts, so no two classes are the same! Each student has music chosen for them based on their current knowledge and ability. Students are allowed time to explore various instrument sounds and rhythm patterns as they compose their own music. Children will receive music to play at home, but owning a piano or keyboard is not required for participation in the class.

Because instruction is customized, this class is appropriate for beginners and students with previous piano keyboarding experience.
