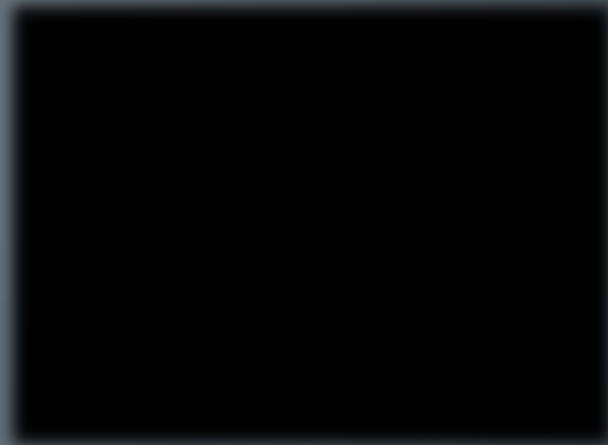


Project Peanut Butter



What is Project Peanut Butter?



How can we take action?

- The cost to rescue a malnourished child through Project Peanut Butter is surprisingly low: only about \$25 per child!
- \$1,000 dollars can save an entire village of malnourished children for one year.
- We can take action by raising money to save a whole village of malnourished children in Malawi!



How will we raise the money?

- This Friday, March 22nd, the Social Justice Leadership Council is hosting PJ's for PB!
- As a part of PJ's for PB, we ask that you wear appropriate Pajamas to school this Friday.
- The cost to wear the Pajama's is \$2, however, you are encouraged to bring in extra donations!
 - NO footed PJ's, NO shorts, NO slippers, NO tank tops, NO nightgowns

How will we raise the money?

- Social Justice will also be having a Peanut Butter themed bake sale on March 22nd during your lunch period.
- Treats include puppy chow, peanut butter cookies, peanut butter brownies, and more!

- Each treat costs 50 cents.
- Please, no more than 2 treats per student!
